We also have a day care/preschool, which has an additional 120 students attending. Now 56 years old, the school opened in the fall of 1964 as a ministry of Curtis Baptist Church and graduated its first senior class in the spring of 1976.

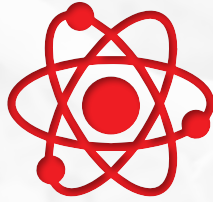

• Rank In Class •

Class ranking will be based on a cumulative grade point average.

Core courses will receive the following weights on a 4.0 scale:

Add 1.0 weight to Advanced Placement courses.

Add 1.0 weight to Dual Enrollment core courses.

Add .5 weight to Honors courses.



• Academic Program •

All academic courses are college preparatory.

Honors & Advanced Placement

Placement is determined by teacher recommendation, grades and standardized test scores.

Dual Enrollment

Opportunity for students to take college courses which will count for high school and college credit.
