Now 56 years old, the school opened in the fall of 1964 as a ministry of Curtis Baptist Church and graduated its first senior class in the spring of 1976.

Rank In Class

Class ranking will be based on a cumulative grade point average.

Core courses will receive the following weights on a 4.0 scale:

Add 1.0 weight to Advanced Placement courses. Add 1.0 weight to Dual Enrollment core courses. Add .5 weight to Honors courses.
