DEADLINE TO APPLY IS MARCH 31, 2021

Applicants must:

1. Be attending Curtis Baptist School in grades K -12 inclusive.
2. Grades 8 – 12 write an essay (200 words or less) on the following:
How would your plans for the future, including your course of study, demonstrate your commitment to Christ as well as your desire to serve others? An evaluation of content, grammar and punctuation will be considered.
3. Letter of recommendation from a Church leader and an academic leader.
4. Pages 1 & 2 of your 2020 Tax return
5. Please complete and return to the **School Finance Office**

Evaluation and selection will be based on the above mentioned criteria.

Award Value and Presentation

All Applicants will be notified by mail when awards are finalized. The CBC Student Scholarship awards will be sent directly to the School. The awards are not renewable; however candidates may reapply in successive years.
